40 DAYS FOR LIFE™ DALLAS

This fall, from September 24 – November 2, 2008, our community will be uniting with over 170 other cities across America – and around the world – for the largest and longest coordinated pro-life mobilization in history – the *40 Days for Life* campaign. People of faith are praying that this effort will mark the beginning of the end of abortion.

40 Days for Life is a focused pro-life campaign that has generated measurable life-saving results in more than 130 cities where it has been implemented. Some locations have reported as much as a 28% drop in local abortion numbers and hundreds of new people getting involved in local life-saving ministry efforts.

The *40 Days for Life* campaign is made up of three key components:

Prayer and Fasting: inviting people of faith throughout our city to join together for 40 days of fervent prayer and fasting for an end to abortion

Peaceful Vigil: standing for life through a 40-day peaceful public witness

This year, 40 Days for Life-Dallas will have *two* Peaceful Vigil sites:

Planned Parenthood abortion center, 7424 Greenville Ave., Dallas

and **Robinson's abortion center**, 1929 Record Crossing, Dallas

Our campaigns will be 24 hours a day/7 days a week

Community Outreach: taking a positive, upbeat pro-life message to every corner of our city through media efforts, church presentations, petition drives, and public visibility
